Please comply with this requirement and do not let your dogs roam at large. Thank you.

Parking: (Not Allowed in Ditches or Grassy Areas)

It's important to realize that parking in ditches, in yards or on grassy areas etc. is not allowed and after proper warning you will be fined and possibly towed. Please also do not block access to any septic tank area with any vehicles. **Also, S. Forest haven Rd is the only section where residents can park on the street.** Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

Children Playing in the Roadways

It is important to realize that children should not be playing on the common roads of the Forest Haven HOA as this is an unnecessary safety risk. I personally know of parents who lost their child who was run over and killed in this manner at a different location. I tell you this so that if you have children playing in the roadways then please realize that you are putting them at great risk. It can only take a moment for an accident to occur that can cause injury or death to a small child. Please do not leave your children to play in the roadways. Thank you for your compliance on this important issue.
